



WINNING YOUR CASE IN PRAYER AND INTERCESSION

Part 1 – December 15, 2013

Revelation 12 ¹⁰ Then I heard a strong (loud) voice in heaven, saying, Now it has come--the salvation and the power and the kingdom (the dominion, the reign) of our God, and the power (the sovereignty, the authority) of His Christ (the Messiah); for the accuser of our brethren, he who keeps bringing before our God charges against them day and night, has been cast out! ¹¹ And they have overcome (conquered) him by means of the blood of the Lamb and by the utterance of their testimony...AMP

Matthew 12 ³⁶ But I tell you, on the day of judgment men will have to give account for every idle (inoperative, nonworking) word they speak. ³⁷ For by your words you will be justified and acquitted, and by your words you will be condemned and sentenced. AMP

Genesis 18 ²⁵ "Far be it from You to do such a thing, to slay the righteous with the wicked, so that the righteous and the wicked are treated alike. Far be it from You! Shall not the Judge of all the earth deal justly?" NASU

Romans 5 ⁸ But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. ⁹ Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from the wrath of God through Him. NASU

Romans 5 ¹⁷ For if by the transgression of the one, death reigned through the one, much more those who receive the abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness will reign in life through the One, Jesus Christ. NASU

1 John 1 ⁹ If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. ¹⁰ If we say that we have not sinned, we make Him a liar and His word is not in us. NASU

Matthew 18 ²¹ Then Peter came and said to Him, "Lord, how often shall my brother sin against me and I forgive him? Up to seven times?" ²² Jesus said to him, "I do not say to you, up to seven times, but up to seventy times seven. NASU

Psalm 89 ¹⁴ Righteousness and justice are the foundation of Your throne; Lovingkindness and truth go before You. NASU

Hebrews 7 ²⁵ Therefore He is able also to save forever those who draw near to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them. NASU

1 Timothy 2 ¹ Therefore I exhort first of all that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks be made for all men, ² for kings and all who are in authority, that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence. ³ For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Savior, ⁴ who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth. ⁵ For there is one God and one Mediator between God and men, the Man Christ Jesus, ⁶ who gave Himself a ransom for all, to be testified in due time... NKJV

Nehemiah 1 ⁶ ...let Your ear now be attentive and Your eyes open to hear the prayer of Your servant which **I am praying before You now, day and night, on behalf of the sons of Israel** Your servants, **confessing the sins of the sons of Israel which we have sinned against You; I and my father's house have sinned.** ⁷ "We have acted very corruptly against You and have not kept the commandments, nor the statutes, nor the ordinances which You commanded Your servant Moses. NASU

Daniel 9 ² ...I, Daniel, observed in the books the number of the years which was revealed as the word of the LORD to Jeremiah the prophet for the completion of the desolations of Jerusalem, namely, seventy years. ³ So I gave my attention to the Lord God to seek Him by prayer and supplications, with fasting, sackcloth and ashes. ⁴ **I prayed to the LORD my God and confessed...⁵... we have sinned, committed iniquity, acted wickedly and rebelled,** even turning aside from Your commandments and ordinances. ⁹ "To the Lord our God belong compassion and forgiveness, for we have rebelled against Him; ¹¹ "**Indeed all Israel has transgressed Your law** and turned aside, not obeying Your voice; **so the curse has been poured out on us,** along with the oath which is written in the law of Moses the servant of God, **for we have sinned against Him.** ¹³ "As it is written in the law of Moses, **all this calamity has come on us; yet we have not sought the favor of the LORD our God by turning from our iniquity** and giving attention to Your truth. ¹⁴ "**Therefore the LORD has kept the calamity in store and brought it on us; for the LORD our God is righteous with respect to all His deeds which He has done, but we have not obeyed His voice.** ¹⁵ "...we have sinned, we have been wicked. ¹⁶ "O Lord, **in accordance with all Your righteous acts, let now Your anger and Your wrath turn away from Your city Jerusalem,** Your holy mountain; **for because of our sins and the iniquities of our fathers,** Jerusalem and Your people have become a reproach to all those around us. ¹⁸ ... **for we are not presenting our supplications before You on account of any merits of our own, but on account of Your great compassion.** ²⁰ Now while I was speaking and praying, and **confessing my sin and the sin of my people Israel,** and presenting my supplication before the LORD my God in behalf of the holy mountain of my God, ²¹ while I was still speaking in prayer, then the man Gabriel, whom I had seen in the vision previously, came to me in my extreme weariness about the time of the evening offering. NASU

Revelation 19 ¹¹ And I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse, and **He who sat on it is called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and wages war.** NASU

Proverbs 26 ² Like a sparrow in its flitting, like a swallow in its flying, So a curse without cause does not alight. NASU

Things To Know about the Accuser

He brings legal issues against you to stop you from your destiny.

Psalm 139 ¹⁶ *Your eyes saw my unformed substance, and in Your book all the days [of my life] were written before ever they took shape, when as yet there was none of them. AMP*

The battle is in the courtroom of heaven. Satan wants to stop you by presenting legal grounds to disqualify you by:

- 1. Our own sins**
- 2. Sin of my bloodline**

(Ex 20 ⁵ *You shall not bow down to them or worship them; for I, the LORD your God, am a jealous God, punishing the children for the sin of the fathers to the third and fourth generation of those who hate me, 6 but showing love to a thousand [generations] of those who love me and keep my commandments. NIV)*

- 3. Accusing us of our motives**

(Job 1 ⁹ *Then Satan answered the LORD, "Does Job fear God for nothing?"* ¹⁰ *"Have You not made a hedge about him and his house and all that he has, on every side? You have blessed the work of his hands,*

and his possessions have increased in the land. ¹¹ " But put forth Your hand now and touch all that he has; he will surely curse You to Your face." NASU)
