



# WINNING YOUR CASE IN PRAYER AND INTERCESSION

Part 4 – January 13, 2014

**Revelation 12** <sup>10</sup> Then I heard a strong (loud) voice in heaven, saying, Now it has come--the salvation and the power and the kingdom (the dominion, the reign) of our God, and the power (the sovereignty, the authority) of His Christ (the Messiah); for the accuser of our brethren, he who keeps bringing before our God charges against them day and night, has been cast out! <sup>11</sup> And they have overcome (conquered) him by means of the blood of the Lamb and by the utterance of their testimony...AMP

**Matthew 12** <sup>36</sup> But I tell you, on the day of judgment men will have to give account for every idle (inoperative, nonworking) word they speak. <sup>37</sup> For by your words you will be justified and acquitted, and by your words you will be condemned and sentenced. AMP

**Hebrews 7** <sup>25</sup> Therefore He is able also to save forever those who draw near to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them. NASU

## Things To Know About The Accuser

He brings legal issues against you to stop you from your destiny. (God's plan for your life.) Everything in the spirit realm is legal, but not necessarily what God wants.

**Psalm 139** <sup>16</sup> Your eyes saw my unformed substance, and in Your book all the days [of my life] were written before ever they took shape, when as yet there was none of them. AMP

**Jeremiah 29** <sup>11</sup> "For I know the plans I have for you," says the LORD. "They are plans for good and not for disaster, to give you a future and a hope. <sup>12</sup> In those days when you pray, I will listen. <sup>13</sup> If you look for Me wholeheartedly, you will find Me. <sup>14</sup> I will be found by you," says the LORD. "I will end your captivity and restore your fortunes." NLT

The battle is in the courtroom of heaven. Satan wants to stop you by presenting legal grounds to disqualify you by:

### 1. Our own sins

**Isaiah 59** <sup>1</sup> Behold, the LORD'S hand is not so short That it cannot save; Nor is His ear so dull That it cannot hear. <sup>2</sup> But your iniquities have made a separation between you and your God, And your sins have hidden His face from you so that He does not hear. <sup>15</sup> ...Now the LORD saw, and it was displeasing in His sight that there was no justice. <sup>16</sup> And He saw that there was no man, And was astonished that there was no one to intercede; Then His own arm brought salvation to Him, And His righteousness upheld Him. NASU

### 2. Sin of my bloodline AND of my society

**Exodus 20** <sup>5</sup> You shall not bow down to them or worship them; for I, the LORD your God, am a jealous God, punishing the children for the sin of the fathers to the third and fourth generation of those who hate me, <sup>6</sup> but showing love to a thousand [generations] of those who love me and keep my commandments. NIV

**Nehemiah 2** <sup>6</sup> let Your ear now be attentive and Your eyes open to hear the prayer of Your servant which I am praying before You now, day and night, on behalf of the sons of Israel Your servants, confessing the

**sins of the sons of Israel which we have sinned against you; I and my father's house have sinned.**

**Daniel 9** <sup>16</sup> "O Lord, in accordance with all Your righteous acts, let now Your anger and Your wrath turn away from Your city Jerusalem, Your holy mountain; **for because of our sins and the iniquities of our fathers,** Jerusalem and Your people have become a reproach to all those around us. NASU

**1 John 1** <sup>8</sup> If we say that we have no sin, we are deceiving ourselves and the truth is not in us. <sup>9</sup> **If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.** NASU

**Lamentations 5** <sup>7</sup> **Our fathers sinned and are no more, and we bear their punishment.** NIV

**1 John 5** <sup>16</sup> **If anyone sees his brother committing a sin** not leading to death, **he shall ask and God will for him give life** to those who commit sin not leading to death. NASU

### 3. Accusing us of our motives

**Job 1** <sup>9</sup> Then Satan answered the LORD, "Does Job fear God for nothing? <sup>10</sup> "Have You not made a hedge about him and his house and all that he has, on every side? You have blessed the work of his hands, and his possessions have increased in the land. <sup>11</sup> " But put forth Your hand now and touch all that he has; he will surely curse You to Your face." NASU

**Psalms 139** <sup>23</sup> **Search me, O God, and know my heart;** test me and know my anxious thoughts. <sup>24</sup> **Point out anything in me that offends you,** and lead me along the path of everlasting life. NLT

**Psalms 51** <sup>10</sup> **Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me.** NASU

## **8 Things To Know To Silence The Accuser**

- 1. Satan as the accuser has been cast down from the third heaven into the second and first heaven.**  
**Revelation 12:10-11** AMP
  - a) Satan can be summoned to the third heaven court
  - b) Satan can request to present a case, because God is just and legal
  - c) Humility has great value and weight with God pride and arrogance is resisted by God. James 4:6
- 2. His accusations are perpetual, even accusations about our bloodline and alignment with others.**  
**Lamentations 5:7** NIV
- 3. He exposes all weaknesses for the purpose of shame, a sense of condemnation, and unworthiness.**  
**We answer by the Blood of Jesus.**
- 4. He uses God's standard against us.** Ezekiel 18:4
- 5. The purpose of the accusation is to steal, kill, and destroy.** John 10:10  
Persevering prayer is not saying the same thing over and over. Luke 18:1-8 It is answering each accusation until everything is answered, then answers to prayer come speedily. Satan has to have a legal right for bad things to happen to good people. Proverbs 26:2
- 6. He tests and tempts us to find grounds to accuse us about.** Matthew 4:1-11
- 7. Know who is the accuser and who is the intercessor (Jesus). You must have the Word of the Lord to silence the accuser.** Matthew 4:4 How do I answer the accusations?
- 8. The accuser will leave us when we have dealt with it all.** Matthew 4:11
