Believe The Truth About God!

Psalm 100 ⁵ For the Lord is good; His mercy and loving-kindness are everlasting, His faithfulness and truth endure to all generations. AMP

⁵ For the Lord is always good and ready to receive you. He's so loving that it will amaze you—so kind that it will astound you! And he is famous for his faithfulness toward all. Everyone knows our God can be trusted, for he keeps his promises to every generation! TPT

Proverbs 4 ¹⁸ But the path of the [uncompromisingly] just and righteous is like the light of dawn, that shines more and more (brighter and clearer) until [it reaches its full strength and glory in] the perfect day [to be prepared]. [2 Sam 23:4; Matt 5:14; Phil 2:15.] AMP

Isaiah 26 ⁷ The way of the [consistently] righteous (those living in moral and spiritual rectitude in every area and relationship of their lives) is level and straight; You, O [Lord], Who are upright, direct aright and make level the path of the [uncompromisingly] just and righteous. AMP

Psalm 34 ¹⁹ Many evils confront the [consistently] righteous, but the Lord delivers him out of them all. AMP

Matthew 11 ³⁰ "For My yoke is easy and My burden is light." NASU

Proverbs 13 ¹⁵ Good understanding wins favor, but the way of the transgressor is hard [like the barren, dry soil or the impassable swamp]. AMP

1 John 4 ¹⁶ We have come to know and have believed the love which God has for us. God is love, and the one who abides in love abides in God, and God abides in him. NASU

Jeremiah 29 ¹¹ 'For I know the plans that I have for you,' declares the Lord, 'plans for welfare and not for calamity to give you a future and a hope.' NASU

1 Peter 5 ⁶ Therefore humble yourselves [demote, lower yourselves in your own estimation] under the mighty hand of God, that in due time He may exalt you, ⁷ Casting the whole of your care [all your anxieties, all your worries, all your concerns, once and for all] on Him, for He cares for you affectionately and cares about you watchfully. [Ps 55:22.] AMP

⁶ If you bow low in God's awesome presence, he will eventually exalt you as you leave the timing in his hands. ⁷ Pour out all your worries and stress upon him and leave them there, for he always tenderly cares for you. TPT

Matthew 25 ²⁴ He who had received one talent also came forward, saying, Master, I knew you to be a harsh and hard man, reaping where you did not sow, and gathering where you had not winnowed [the grain]. ²⁵ So I was afraid, and I went and hid your talent in the ground. Here you have what is your own. ²⁶ But his master answered him, You wicked and lazy and idle servant! Did you indeed know that I reap where I have not sowed and gather [grain]

where I have not winnowed? ²⁷ Then you should have invested my money with the bankers, and at my coming I would have received what was my own with interest. ²⁸ So take the talent away from him and give it to the one who has the ten talents. AMP

Philippians 4 ⁶ Don't worry about anything; instead, pray about everything. Tell God what you need, and thank him for all he has done. NLT

⁶ Don't be pulled in different directions or worried about a thing. Be saturated in prayer throughout each day, offering your faith-filled requests before God with overflowing gratitude. Tell him every detail of your life, TPT

James 4 ² You jealously want what others have so you begin to see yourself as better than others. You scheme with envy and harm others to selfishly obtain what you crave—that's why you quarrel and fight. And all the time you don't obtain what you want because you won't ask God for it! ³ And if you ask, you won't receive it for you're asking with corrupt motives, seeking only to fulfill your own selfish desires. TPT

Matthew 6 ⁹ "Pray, then, in this way: 'Our Father who is in heaven, Hallowed be Your name. ¹⁰ 'Your kingdom come. Your will be done, On earth as it is in heaven. NASU

Your Relationships Are Important

1 Peter 3 ⁷ In the same way, you husbands must give honor to your wives. Treat your wife with understanding as you live together. She may be weaker than you are, but she is your equal partner in God's gift of new life. Treat her as you should so your prayers will not be hindered. NLT

Matthew 5 ²³ "So then, if you are presenting a gift before the altar in the temple and suddenly you remember a quarrel you have with a fellow believer, ²⁴ leave your gift there in front of the altar and go at once to apologize with the one who is offended. Then, after you have reconciled, come to the altar and present your gift. TPT

2 Samuel 21 ¹ THERE WAS a three-year famine in the days of David, year after year; and David inquired of the Lord. The Lord replied, It is on account of Saul and his bloody house, for he put to death the Gibeonites. ² So the king called the Gibeonites — now the Gibeonites were not Israelites but of the remnant of the Amorites. The Israelites had sworn to spare them, but Saul in his zeal for the people of Israel and Judah had sought to slay the Gibeonites — ³ So David said to the Gibeonites, What shall I do for you? How can I make atonement that you may bless the Lord's inheritance? ⁴ The Gibeonites said to him, We will accept no silver or gold of Saul or of his house; neither for us shall you kill any man in Israel. David said, I will do for you what you say. ⁵ They said to the king, The man who consumed us and planned to prevent us from remaining in any territory of Israel, ⁶ Let seven men of his sons be delivered to us and we will hang them up before the Lord at Gibeah of Saul, [on the mountain] of the Lord. And the king said, I will give them. ^{14b} ... And after that, God heard and answered when His people prayed for the land. AMP
