Believe The Truth About God! - Who Are You Praying To?

Psalm 100 ⁵ **For the Lord is always good and ready to receive you.** He's so loving that it will amaze you—so kind that it will astound you! And he is famous for his faithfulness toward all. **Everyone knows our God can be trusted, for he keeps his promises to every generation!** TPT

Psalm 34 ¹⁹ **Even when bad things happen to the good and godly ones, the Lord will save them and not let them be defeated by what they face.** TPT

Matthew 11 ³⁰ **"For My yoke is easy** and My burden is light." NASU ³⁰ For all that I require of you will be pleasant and easy to bear. TPT

Deuteronomy 30 ¹⁹ "Today I have given you the choice between life and death, between blessings and curses. Now I call on heaven and earth to witness the choice you make. Oh, that you would choose life, so that you and your descendants might live! ²⁰ You can make this choice by loving the Lord your God, obeying him, and committing yourself firmly to him. This is the key to your life. And if you love and obey the Lord, you will live long in the land the Lord swore to give your ancestors Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob." NLT

1 John 4 ¹⁶ **We have come to know and have believed the love which God has for us. God is love,** and the one who abides in love abides in God, and God abides in him. NASU

Jeremiah 29 ¹¹ **'For I know the plans that I have for you,' declares the Lord, 'plans for welfare and not for calamity to give you a future and a hope.** ¹² 'Then you will call upon Me and come and pray to Me, and I will listen to you. NASU

1 Peter 5 ⁵ ...God resists you when you are proud but multiplies grace and favor when you are humble ⁶ Therefore **humble yourselves** [demote, lower yourselves in your own estimation] under the mighty hand of God, **that in due time He may exalt you,** ⁷ **Casting the whole of your care [all your anxieties, all your worries, all your concerns, once and for all] on Him,** for He cares for you affectionately and cares about you watchfully. [Ps 55:22.] AMP
⁶ If you bow low in God's awesome presence, he will eventually exalt you as you leave the timing in his hands. ⁷ **Pour out all your worries and stress upon him and leave them there, for he always tenderly cares for you.** TPT

Pray, Trusting In Your Father

Philippians 4 ⁶ **Don't worry about anything; instead, pray about everything. Tell God what you need, and thank him for all he has done.** NLT

⁶ Don't be pulled in different directions or worried about a thing. Be saturated in prayer throughout each day, offering your faith-filled requests before God with overflowing gratitude. **Tell him every detail of your life,** TPT

James 4 ² You jealously want what others have so you begin to see yourself as better than others. You scheme with envy and harm others to selfishly obtain what you crave—that's why you quarrel and fight. And all the time **you don't obtain what you want because you won't ask God for it!** ³ And if you ask, you won't receive it for you're asking with corrupt motives, seeking only to fulfill your own selfish desires. TPT

Your Relationships Are Important

1 Peter 3 ⁷ In the same way, **you husbands must give honor to your wives.** Treat your wife with understanding as you live together. She may be weaker than you are, but she is your equal partner in God's gift of new life. **Treat her as you should so your prayers will not be hindered.** NLT

Matthew 5 ²³ "So then, if you are presenting a gift before the altar in the temple and suddenly you remember a quarrel you have with a fellow believer, ²⁴ leave your gift there in front of the altar and go at once to apologize with the one who is offended. Then, **after you have reconciled, come to the altar and present your gift.** TPT

2 Samuel 21 ¹ **THERE WAS a three-year famine in the days of David, year after year; and David inquired of the Lord. The Lord replied,** It is on account of Saul and his bloody house, for he put to death the Gibeonites. ² So the king called the Gibeonites — now the Gibeonites were not Israelites but of the remnant of the Amorites. The Israelites had sworn to spare them, but Saul in his zeal for the people of Israel and Judah had sought to slay the Gibeonites — ³ So David said to the Gibeonites, **What shall I do for you? How can I make atonement that you may bless the Lord's inheritance?** ⁴ The Gibeonites said to him, We will accept no silver or gold of Saul or of his house; neither for us shall you kill any man in Israel. David said, I will do for you what you say. ⁵ They said to the king, The man who consumed us and planned to prevent us from remaining in any territory of Israel, ⁶ Let seven men of his sons be delivered to us and we will hang them up before the Lord at Gibeah of Saul, [on the mountain] of the Lord. **And the king said, I will give them.** ^{14b} ... **And after that, God heard and answered when His people prayed for the land.** AMP

Proverbs 26 ² Like a sparrow in its flitting, like a swallow in its flying, **So a curse without cause does not alight.** NASU

2 Chronicles 7 ¹⁴ and My people who are called by My name humble themselves and pray and seek My face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, will forgive their sin and will heal their land. NASU
