**Matthew 5** <sup>23</sup> **"So then, if you are presenting a gift before the altar in the temple and suddenly you remember a quarrel you have with a fellow believer,** <sup>24</sup> **leave your gift there in front of the altar and go at once to apologize with the one who is offended. Then, after you have reconciled, come to the altar and present your gift.** TPT

## **If Your Prayers Are Not Being Answered, Ask God Why**

**2 Samuel 21** <sup>1</sup> **THERE WAS a three-year famine in the days of David, year after year; and David inquired of the Lord. The Lord replied,** It is on account of Saul and his bloody house, for he put to death the Gibeonites. <sup>2</sup> So the king called the Gibeonites — now the Gibeonites were not Israelites but of the remnant of the Amorites. The Israelites had sworn to

spare them, but Saul in his zeal for the people of Israel and Judah had sought to slay the Gibeonites — <sup>3</sup> So David said to the Gibeonites, **What shall I do for you? How can I make atonement that you may bless the Lord's inheritance?** <sup>4</sup> The Gibeonites said to him, We will accept no silver or gold of Saul or of his house; neither for us shall you kill any man in Israel. David said, I will do for you what you say. <sup>5</sup> They said to the king, The man who consumed us and planned to prevent us from remaining in any territory of Israel, <sup>6</sup> Let seven men of his sons be delivered to us and we will hang them up before the Lord at Gibeah of Saul, [on the mountain] of the Lord. **And the king said, I will give them.** <sup>14b</sup> ... **And after that, God heard and answered when His people prayed for the land.** AMP

**Proverbs 26** <sup>2</sup> Like a sparrow in its flitting, like a swallow in its flying, **So a curse without cause does not alight.** NASU (Deuteronomy 28)

## **Pray In Faith**

**Mark 11** <sup>22</sup> Jesus replied, “Let the faith of God be in you! <sup>23</sup> Listen to the truth I speak to you: If someone says to this mountain with great faith and having no doubt, ‘Mountain, be lifted up and thrown into the midst of the sea,’ and **believes that what he says will happen, it will be done.** <sup>24</sup> This is the reason I urge you to **boldly believe for whatever you ask for in prayer—believe that you have received it and it will be yours.** <sup>25</sup> And whenever you stand praying, if you find that you carry something in your heart against another person, **release him and forgive him** so that your Father in heaven will also release you and forgive you of your faults. <sup>26</sup> But if you will not release forgiveness, don’t expect your Father in heaven to release you from your misdeeds.” TPT

**1 John 5** <sup>11</sup> And the testimony is this, that God has given us eternal life, and this life is in His Son. <sup>12</sup> He who has the Son has the life; he who does not have the Son of God does not have the life. <sup>13</sup> These things I have written to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, so that you may know that you have eternal life. <sup>14</sup> This is the confidence which we have before Him, that, **if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us.** <sup>15</sup> And if we know that He hears us in whatever we ask, **we know that we have the requests which we have asked from Him.** NASU

<sup>14</sup> **Since we have this confidence, we can also have great boldness before him, for if we present any request agreeable to his will, he will hear us.** <sup>15</sup> And if we know that he hears us in whatever we ask, we also know that **we have obtained the requests we ask of him.** TPT

<sup>14</sup> And this is the confidence (the assurance, the privilege of boldness) which we have in Him: [we are sure] that if we ask anything (make any request) according to His will (in agreement with His own plan), He listens to and hears us. <sup>15</sup> And if (since) we [positively] know that He listens to us in whatever we ask, we also know [with settled and absolute knowledge] that **we have [granted us as our present possessions] the requests made of Him.** AMP

**Hebrews 4** <sup>16</sup> Therefore let us draw near with confidence to the throne of grace, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need. NASU

<sup>16</sup> **So now we come freely and boldly to where love is enthroned,** to receive mercy’s kiss and discover the grace we urgently need to strengthen us in our time of weakness. TPT
