**Psalms 110** <sup>1</sup> **The Lord says to my Lord: "Sit at My right hand Until I make Your enemies a footstool for Your feet."** <sup>2</sup> The Lord will stretch forth Your strong scepter from Zion, saying, **"Rule in the midst of Your enemies."** NASU

**Hebrews 10** <sup>12</sup> but He, having offered one sacrifice for sins for all time, SAT DOWN AT THE RIGHT HAND OF GOD, <sup>13</sup> waiting from that time onward UNTIL HIS ENEMIES BE MADE A FOOTSTOOL FOR HIS FEET. <sup>14</sup> For by one offering He has perfected for all time those who are sanctified. **Mark 4** <sup>30</sup> And He said, "How shall we picture **the kingdom of God,** or by what parable shall we present it? <sup>31</sup> "It is like a mustard seed, which, when

sown upon the soil, though it is smaller than all the seeds that are upon the soil, <sup>32</sup> yet when it is sown, it grows up and becomes larger than all the garden plants and forms large branches; so that THE BIRDS OF THE AIR can NEST UNDER ITS SHADE." NASU

**Proverbs 4** <sup>18</sup> But the path of the righteous is like the light of dawn, That shines brighter and brighter until the full day. NASU

**Psalms 92** <sup>12</sup> The righteous man will flourish like the palm tree, He will grow like a cedar in Lebanon. <sup>13</sup> Planted in the house of the Lord, They will flourish in the courts of our God. <sup>14</sup> They will still yield fruit in old age; They shall be full of sap and very green, NASU

**Revelation 17** <sup>14</sup> "These will wage war against the Lamb, and the Lamb will overcome them, because He is Lord of lords and King of kings, and those who are with Him are the called and chosen and faithful." NASU

**CALLED - NT:2822** kletos (klay-tos'); from the same as NT:2821; invited, i.e. appointed, or (specifically) a saint: KJV - called.

**CHOSEN - NT:1587** eklektos (ek-lek-tos'); from NT:1586; select; by implication, favorite: KJV - chosen, elect.

**FAITHFUL - NT:4103** pistos (pis-tos'); from NT:3982; objectively, trustworthy; subjectively, trustful: KJV - believe (-ing, -r), faithful (-ly), sure, true.

**Revelation 19** <sup>15</sup> From His mouth comes a sharp sword, so that with it He may strike down the nations, and He will rule them with a rod of iron; and He treads the wine press of the fierce wrath of God, the Almighty. <sup>16</sup> And on His robe and on His thigh He has a name written, "KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS."
