## God's Word Is Truth

**John 8** <sup>31</sup> So Jesus said to those Jews who had believed in Him, **If you abide in My word [hold fast to My teachings and live in accordance with them], you are truly My disciples.** <sup>32</sup> And **you will know the Truth, and the Truth will set you free.** AMP

## All Saved

**Salvation: Soteria** Strong's #4991 all-inclusive word signifying forgiveness, **healing**, prosperity, deliverance, safety, rescue, liberation, and restoration.

**1 Timothy 2** <sup>1</sup> I urge you, **first of all**, to pray for all people. Ask God to help them; intercede on their behalf, and give thanks for them. <sup>2</sup> Pray this way for kings and all who are in authority so that we can live peaceful and quiet lives marked by godliness and dignity. <sup>3</sup> This is good and pleases God our Savior, <sup>4</sup> **who wants everyone to be saved and to understand the truth.** NLT

## Healing

**Luke 7** <sup>21</sup> At that very time, **Jesus cured many people of their diseases and illnesses**, and he cast out evil spirits and restored sight to many who were blind. <sup>22</sup> Then he told John's disciples, "Go back to John and tell him what you have seen and heard—the blind see, the lame walk, the lepers are cured, the deaf hear, the dead are raised to life, and **the Good News is being preached to the poor.** <sup>23</sup> And tell him, 'God blesses those who do not turn away because of me.'" NLT

**Acts 10** <sup>38</sup> "You know of Jesus of Nazareth, how God anointed Him with the Holy Spirit and with power, and **how He went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.** NASU

## Long Life

**Psalms 91** <sup>16</sup> "With a long life I will satisfy him And let him see My salvation." NASU

**Job 5** <sup>26</sup> You will go to the grave at a ripe old age, like a sheaf of grain harvested at the proper time! NLT

**Genesis 6** <sup>3</sup> Then the Lord said, "My Spirit shall not strive with man forever, because he also is flesh; nevertheless his days shall be one hundred and twenty years. NASU

**Genesis 25** <sup>7</sup> These are all the years of Abraham's life that he lived, one hundred and seventy-five years. <sup>8</sup> Abraham breathed his last and died in a ripe old age, an old man and satisfied with life; and he was gathered to his people. NASU

**Galatians 3** <sup>9</sup> So then those who are of faith are blessed with Abraham, the believer. NASU

**Psalms 21** <sup>4</sup> He asked life of You, and You gave it to him — long life forever and evermore. AMP

**Proverb 3** <sup>1</sup> My son, do not forget my teaching, But let your heart keep my commandments; <sup>2</sup> For length of days and years of life And peace they will add to you. <sup>13</sup> How blessed is the man who finds wisdom And the man who gains understanding. <sup>14</sup> For her profit is better than the profit of silver And her gain better than fine gold. <sup>15</sup> She is more precious than jewels; And nothing you desire compares with her. <sup>16</sup> Long life is in her right hand; In her left hand are riches and honor. NASU

**Proverb 22** <sup>4</sup> True humility and fear of the Lord lead to riches, honor, and long life. NLT

**Isaiah 65** <sup>20</sup> "No longer will babies die when only a few days old. No longer will adults die before they have lived a full life. No longer will people be considered old at one hundred! Only the cursed will die that young! <sup>21</sup> In those days people will live in the houses they build and eat the fruit of their own vineyards. <sup>22</sup> Unlike the past, invaders will not take their houses and confiscate their vineyards. For my people will live as long as trees, and my chosen ones will have time to enjoy their hard-won gains. NLT

### **Hate Evil**

**Psalms 97** <sup>10</sup> You who love the Lord, **hate evil!** He protects the lives of his godly people and rescues them from the power of the wicked. NLT

**Psalms 101** <sup>3</sup> I will refuse to look at anything vile and vulgar. I hate all who deal crookedly; I will have nothing to do with them. NLT

**Psalms 119** <sup>163</sup> I hate and abhor all falsehood, but I love your instructions. NLT

**Proverb 6** <sup>16</sup> There are six things the Lord hates—no, seven things he detests: <sup>17</sup> haughty eyes, a lying tongue, hands that kill the innocent, <sup>18</sup> a heart that plots evil, feet that race to do wrong, <sup>19</sup> a false witness who pours out lies, a person who sows discord in a family. NLT

**Proverb 8** <sup>13</sup> All who fear the Lord will **hate evil**. Therefore, I hate pride and arrogance, corruption and perverse speech. NLT

**Proverb 17** <sup>15</sup> Acquitting the guilty and condemning the innocent—both are detestable to the Lord. NLT

### **Divorce**

**Malachi 2** <sup>15</sup> Didn't the Lord make you one with your wife? In body and spirit you are his. And what does he want? Godly children from your union. So guard your heart; remain loyal to the wife of your youth. <sup>16</sup> "**For I hate divorce!**" says the Lord, the God of Israel. "To divorce your wife is to overwhelm her with cruelty," says the Lord of Heaven's Armies. "So guard your heart; do not be unfaithful to your wife." NLT
