## Redeemed From The Curses: Poverty, Sickness and Spiritual Death

**Deuteronomy 28** <sup>15</sup> "But if you refuse to listen to the Lord your God and do not obey all the commands and decrees I am giving you today, all these curses will come and overwhelm you: <sup>16</sup> Your towns and your fields will be cursed. <sup>18</sup> Your children and your crops will be cursed. <sup>20</sup> ...curses, confusion, and frustration in everything you do, until at last you are completely destroyed for doing evil and abandoning me. <sup>21</sup> ...diseases until none of you are left <sup>22</sup> ...wasting diseases, fever, and inflammation, with scorching heat and drought, and with blight and mildew. These disasters will pursue you until you die. <sup>25</sup> ...defeated by your enemies. <sup>27</sup> ...the boils of Egypt and with tumors, scurvy, and the itch, from which you cannot be cured. <sup>28</sup> ...madness, blindness, and panic. <sup>29</sup> ...oppressed and robbed continually, and no one will come to save you. <sup>30</sup> ...You will build a house, but someone else will live in it... <sup>32</sup> ...your sons and daughters are taken away as slaves. Your heart will break for them, but you won't be able to help them. <sup>33</sup> ...suffer under constant oppression and harsh treatment. <sup>34</sup> You will go mad because of all the tragedy you see around you. <sup>36</sup> ...exile you and your king to a nation unknown to you and your ancestors. There in exile you will worship gods of wood and stone! <sup>38</sup> "You will plant much but harvest little... <sup>41</sup> You will have sons and daughters, but you will lose them, for they will be led away into captivity. <sup>42</sup> ...insects will destroy your trees and crops. <sup>43</sup> ...foreigners living among you will become stronger and stronger, while you become weaker and weaker. <sup>45</sup> ...all these curses will pursue and overtake you until you are destroyed. <sup>46</sup> These horrors will serve as a sign and warning among you and your descendants forever. <sup>47</sup> If you do not serve the Lord your God with joy and enthusiasm for the abundant benefits you have received, <sup>48</sup> ...hungry, thirsty, naked, and lacking in everything. <sup>49</sup> ...a distant nation against you from the end of the earth, <sup>50</sup> ...that shows no respect for the old and no pity for the young. <sup>51</sup> ...you will starve to death. <sup>52</sup> They will attack your cities until all the fortified walls in your land—the walls you trusted to protect you—are knocked down... <sup>53</sup> ...you will eat the flesh of your own sons and daughters, whom the Lord your God has given you. <sup>60</sup> He will afflict you with all the diseases of Egypt that you feared so much, and you will have no relief. <sup>61</sup> The Lord will afflict you with every sickness and plague there is, even those not mentioned in this Book of Instruction, until you are destroyed. <sup>62</sup> Though you become as numerous as the stars in the sky, few of you will be left because you would not listen to the Lord your God. <sup>63</sup> Just as the Lord has found great pleasure in causing you to prosper and multiply, the Lord will find pleasure in destroying you. You will be torn from the land you are about to enter and occupy. <sup>66</sup> You will live night and day in fear, unsure if you will survive. <sup>67</sup> ...you will be terrified by the awful horrors you see around you. ## The Blessings of Abraham

**Isaiah 53** <sup>4</sup> Surely He has borne our griefs (sicknesses, weaknesses, and distresses) and carried our sorrows and pains [of punishment], yet we [ignorantly] considered Him stricken, smitten, and afflicted by God [as if with leprosy]. <sup>5</sup> But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our guilt *and* iniquities; the chastisement [needful to obtain] peace *and* well-being for us was upon Him, and with the stripes [that wounded] Him we are healed and made whole. <sup>6</sup> All we like sheep have gone astray, we have turned every one to his own way; and the Lord has made to light upon Him the guilt *and* iniquity of us all. AMPC

**Matthew 8** <sup>16</sup> When evening came, they brought to Him many who were under the power of demons, and He drove out the spirits with a word and restored to health all who were sick. <sup>17</sup> And thus He fulfilled what was spoken by the prophet Isaiah, He Himself took [in order to carry away] our weaknesses and infirmities and bore away our diseases. AMPC

**1 Peter 2** <sup>24</sup> He personally bore our sins in His [own] body on the tree [as on an altar and offered Himself on it], that we might die (cease to exist) to sin and live to righteousness. By His wounds you have been healed. AMPC

**3 John** <sup>1-4</sup> ... I LOVE YOU! ... I wish ABOVE ALL THINGS that you PROSPER and ENJOY HEALTH, even as you are STRONG IN SPIRIT... NOTHING COULD MAKE ME HAPPIER

**Deuteronomy 28** <sup>1</sup> If you will listen diligently to the voice of the Lord your God, being watchful to do all His commandments which I command you this day, the Lord your God will set you high above all the nations of the earth. <sup>2</sup> And all these blessings shall come upon you and overtake you if you heed the voice of the Lord your God. <sup>3</sup> Blessed shall you be in the city and blessed shall you be in the field. <sup>4</sup> Blessed shall be the fruit of your body and the fruit of your ground and the fruit of your beasts, the increase of your cattle and the young of your flock. <sup>5</sup> Blessed shall be your basket and your kneading trough. <sup>6</sup> Blessed shall you be when you come in and blessed shall you be when you go out. <sup>7</sup> The Lord shall cause your enemies who rise up against you to be defeated before your face; they shall come out against you one way and flee before you seven ways. <sup>8</sup> The Lord shall command the blessing upon you in your storehouse and in all that you undertake. And He will bless you in the land which the Lord your God gives you. <sup>9</sup> The Lord will establish you as a people holy to Himself, as He has sworn to you, if you keep the commandments of the Lord your God and walk in His ways. <sup>10</sup> And all people of the earth shall see that you are called by the name [and in the presence of] the Lord, and they shall be afraid of you. <sup>11</sup> And the Lord shall make you have a surplus of prosperity, through the fruit of your body, of your livestock, and of your ground, in the land which the Lord swore to your fathers to give you. <sup>12</sup> The Lord shall open to you His good treasury, the heavens, to give the rain of your land in its season and to bless all the work of your hands; and you shall lend to many nations, but you shall not borrow. <sup>13</sup> And the Lord shall make you the head, and not the tail; and you shall be above only, and you shall not be beneath, if you heed the commandments of the Lord your God which I command you this day and are watchful to do them. <sup>14</sup> And you shall not turn aside from any of the words which I command you this day, to the right hand or to the left, to go after other gods to serve them.
